About Eastern State Hospital

Eastern State Hospital (ESH) cares for adult psychiatric inpatients on the campus in Medical Lake, Washington., which is located 15 miles west of downtown Spokane. The Hospital opened in 1891, and ever since has played a vital role in helping generations of Washington state residents receive evaluation and inpatient therapy and treatment for mental illness.

ESH hosts both the Eastlake and Westlake campuses. The facility is a 375-bed in-patient psychiatric hospital serving adults and is accredited by the Joint Commission and certified by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

ESH is owned and operated by the State of Washington under the administration of the Department of Social and Health Services.

The Chief Medical Officer (CMO) plans, organizes, controls and evaluates all clinical administrative components to assure a supportive environment toward the delivery of the highest quality of services. The CMO supervises a senior medical leadership team and provide clinical and administrative directions to all medical and clinical medical services staff.


Primary Responsibilities:
